



COLOUR:

When poured, a rich foam appears building a thick trail of tiny bubbles. The colour is crystal clear displaying old-gold reflections.

NOSE:

The first nose is expressive and powerful. It reveals beautiful, mature aromas of candied fruit and baked apples. Subtle Mirabelle plum notes appear after aeration, followed by a hint of dry spices on the finish.

PALATE:

The round attack on the palate is well balanced. The wine offers notes of small dried fruit, a nice body and structure. The quite long finish reveals a delightful harmony between maturity and lingering freshness.
