

EYE:

Yellow gold, clear and shiny wine with golden hues. A lively sparkle with a lovely carpet of bubbles on the surface.

NOSE:

A pleasant maturity, with notes of ripe hay and bread crust. After airing, subtle notes of cocoa and mild blond tobacco come out, blended with hazelnuts and cashew nuts.

MOUTH:

Full, rich, complex and silky, with a lovely balance and freshness. Dried fruit flavours (apricot and pineapple) are a perfect match with roasted tobacco and hay notes again.

CONCLUSION:

This old reserve wine, with its rich and open maturity, will seduce you with its lovely freshness.
