

**EYE:**

The head is plentiful when serving. A thin string of tiny bubbles is persistent around the rim. A lovely clear pink colour with salmon hues.

NOSE:

The first nose brings out a pleasant maturity with aromas of stewed fruit. After airing come out notes of orange rind. The finale is striking with a touch of pomelo and fruit in spirits.

MOUTH:

The attack is neat and lively. Flavours of stewed fruit in syrup and a slight but pleasant and noble bitterness in the finale.

CONCLUSION :

A nice and ripe rosé champagne, perfect all along a meal.
